

iPiPE Public Website Privacy Policy

iPiPE is committed to protecting your privacy and developing technology that gives you the most powerful and safe online experience. This iPiPE Public Website Privacy Policy (“Privacy Policy”) applies to your use of the Public Website (“Site”) or any of the information, products, or services offered on this Site (collectively, the “Services”). This Privacy Policy governs the collection and usage of term definitions stored and displayed on the Site. By using the Site, you consent to the Privacy Policy practices described in this statement.

Use of your Personal Information

iPiPE may need to collect and use personal information to develop and operate the Site and deliver its Services to you. iPiPE may use your personally identifiable information to inform you of other products or services available from iPiPE and its affiliates. iPiPE may also contact you via surveys to conduct research about your opinion of current services or of potential new services that may be offered.

iPiPE does not sell, rent or lease its customer lists to third parties. iPiPE may, from time to time, contact you on behalf of external business partners about a particular offering that may be of interest to you. In those cases, your unique personally identifiable information (e-mail, name, address, telephone number) is not transferred to the third party. In addition, iPiPE may share data with trusted partners to help us perform statistical analysis, send you email or postal mail, provide customer support, or arrange for deliveries. All such third parties are prohibited from using your personal information except to provide these services to iPiPE, and they are required to maintain the confidentiality of your information.

iPiPE does not use or disclose sensitive personal information, such as race, religion, or political affiliations, without your explicit consent.

iPiPE keeps track of the Site and pages our customers visit within iPiPE, in order to determine what iPiPE services are the most popular. This data is used to deliver customized content and advertising within iPiPE to customers whose behavior indicates that they are interested in a particular subject area.

iPiPE websites, including this Site, will disclose your personal information, without notice, only if required to do so by law or in the good faith belief that such action is necessary to: (a) conform to the edicts of the law or comply with legal process served on iPiPE or the site; (b) protect and defend the rights or property of iPiPE; and, (c) act under exigent circumstances to protect the personal safety of users of iPiPE, or the public.

Use of Cookies

The iPiPE Site uses "cookies" to help you personalize your online experience. A cookie is a text file that is placed on your hard disk by a Web page server. Cookies cannot be used to run programs or deliver viruses to your computer. Cookies are uniquely assigned to you, and can only be read by a web server in the domain that issued the cookie to you.

One of the primary purposes of cookies is to provide a convenience feature to save you time. The purpose of a cookie is to tell the Web server that you have returned to a specific page. For example, if you personalize iPiPE pages, or register with iPiPE site or services, a cookie helps iPiPE to recall your specific information on subsequent visits. This simplifies the process of recording your personal information, such as billing addresses, shipping addresses, and so on. When you return to the same iPiPE Site, the information you previously provided can be retrieved, so you can easily use the iPiPE features that you customized.

You have the ability to accept or decline cookies. Most Web browsers automatically accept cookies, but you can usually modify your browser setting to decline cookies if you prefer. If you choose to decline cookies, you may not be able to fully experience the interactive features of the iPiPE services or Web sites you visit.

Security of your Personal Information

iPiPE secures your personal information from unauthorized access, use or disclosure. iPiPE secures the personally identifiable information you provide on computer servers in a controlled, secure environment, protected from unauthorized access, use or disclosure. When personal information (such as a credit card number) is transmitted to other websites, it is protected through the use of encryption, such as the Secure Socket Layer (SSL) protocol.
